If you submit a 1099 to us at the end of the year, you will still be required to submit it under our old Tax ID number of 47-1310094 from January 1, 2017 thru June 30, 2017. After July 1, 2017, you are no longer required to send us a 1099. For those that need to know, our new tax ID number is 82-1255211, our new alarm license number is ACO7695 and our new DIR Public Works Contractor Registration number is 1000050987. DID YOU KNOW?

- According to the FBI, a home burglary occurs every 13 seconds in the US. Many times a burglar will target a home within a few miles of their own home.
- Did you know the most common point of entry for a burglar is the front door? Many times the door is unlocked, which is an open invitation for a burglar. The burglar may first knock to determine if anyone is home, then jiggle the doorknob to see if it is unlocked. This doesn't mean that they won't try other avenues of entry like the garage to house door, back door, or an open window. Never leave an open window, even if you are just running a short errand.
- The first room usually targeted is the master bedroom where safes, jewelry, cash, and guns can be found.
- Most burglaries occur between 6 am and 6 pm while you are at work. The most common hours for a burglary are between 10 am and 3 pm.
- While having a security system does not guarantee that there will never be a break-in, homes without a security systems are about three times more likely to be targeted than homes with a security systems. Most of the time, when a burglar sees evidence of a security system they look elsewhere for easier targets.
- There are things you can do to keep your home or business from being an easy target. Install jams on windows and patio doors, make sure you have deadbolts on all your doors, lock your doors, keep shrubbery trimmed around windows and entryways, install outdoor lighting, and install a security system.
