CALL LIST INFORMATION UPDATES

Our goal is to keep accurate account information at all times, but we cannot do it without your help.

If you change your contact information, please let us know. If you have a change in personnel, make sure to update your password list. You may have to issue a new code or delete a code depending on the situation.

Ask our dispatchers for a current call list. They can send one to you for an update at any time.

Don't wait until there is an emergency situation, keep current information on file at all times.

Summer Safety Tips From NFPA

Summer is here. It is time to do those remodeling projects that you have been putting off all winter. Time to paint, stain and varnish. Did you know that oils commonly used in oil-based paints and stains release heat as they dry. If the heat is not released in the air, it builds up. That is why a pile of oily rags can be dangerous. As the rags dry, the heat is trapped. The heat builds up and finally causes a fire. Be aware that this does not happen with water-based finishes.

Liquids can also start a fire. Vapors from flammable and combustible liquids can ignite, causing a fire. There are many commonly used flammable liquids. Gasoline, lacquers, and nail polish are just a few examples. There are many commonly used combustible liquids, paint thinner, kerosene, and oil-based paints and stains are some examples.

FACT: An average of 1,600 home fires per year are caused by instances of spontaneous combustion or chemical reaction.

FACT: An average of 800 home fires per year are started when oily rags catch fire or are ignited.

Don't leave cleaning rags in a pile. Hang the rags outside. Keep them away from buildings. Put dried rags in a metal container. Make sure the cover is tight and fill the container with water and detergent solution. This will break down the oils. Check with your town for information on disposing of them.

Use gasoline as a motor fuel only. Never use it as a cleaner or to break down grease. Never bring gasoline indoors, even in small amounts. Store gasoline ONLY in a container that is sold for that purpose. Make sure the container is tightly capped and never store gas in containers in a basement or in the occupied space of a building. Keep them in an outbuilding, shed or detached garage.

SAFETY-PROOFING YOUR HOME FOR BABY

1. Save the national poison control hotline in your phone and post it at home, in case your baby ingests something he or she shouldn't: (800)222-1222.
2. Secure heavy furniture to the wall (e.g. TV's, bookshelves, changing tables, dressers, etc.) with brackets and furniture straps to prevent furniture from falling on your baby or toddler. Never put a TV on top of a dresser, drawers can be used for climbing.
3. Use childproofing products throughout your home: electrical outlet covers, safety gates at tops and bottoms of staircases, cabinet and drawer locks, adhesive foam bumpers on coffee table corners and fireplace hearths.
4. Take an infant CPR course.
5. You might not see your toilet as a hazard, but the water in it, and the toilet lid, can be a danger for a curious child. Prevent problems: Remember to always keep the toilet lids down and secured with a lid lock.
